

Orienteering Event in the Catalina Mtns. Girl Scout Camp Sunday~ September 20

The Tucson Orienteering Club will hold an orienteering event on Sunday, September 20, at the Girl Scout Camp in the Catalina Mountains. To arrive there from Tucson, take the Catalina Highway up Mt. Lemmon to a few feet short of Milepost 20. The turnoff--ORGANIZATION RIDGE--will be on the left. Follow the dirt road 1.2 miles to the end. The road is not in very good condition, so an alternate choice would be to park across from the Palisades Ranger Station and carpool into the site.

Orienteering is the sport of cross country navigation around a pre-set course using a map and a compass. It is a sport for the whole family to enjoy at leisure, or a sport for those who like the challenge of competition.

At each event someone will be available to give instruction on the basics of orienteering, map reading, and use of a compass. Courses will be offered for all levels of ability, and you may participate in one of two categories: competitive--you are timed and rated among others who are running the same course; or, recreational--take your time and enjoy the out-of-doors while you have the fun and challenge of finding all the controls.

Entrants may register as individuals or as families and teams. Entry fees are as follows:


Individual \$3.00 Family or Team \$5.00
