• DIRECTIONS:

FROM TUCSON-TAKE I-10 EAST (TOWARD EL PASO) TO EXIT 281, AZ. STATE HWY 83. DRIVE SOUTH ON HWY 83 FOR 21 MILES TO GARDENER CANYON ROAD, BETWEEN MP 37 & MP 38, ON THE RIGHT.

FOLLOW DIRT ROAD WEST TOWARDS GARDENER CANYON. DRIVE 3 1/2 MI. TO A STEEP WASH.
A SHUTTLE EVERY 1/2 HR TO THE REGISTRATION AREA. HIGH CLEARANCE VEHICLES CAN ALSO MAKE THE TRIP.

FROM SIERRA VISTA-TAKE AZ. 82 WEST TO SONOITA. GO NORTH 4 MILES TO GARDENER CANYON ROAD.
