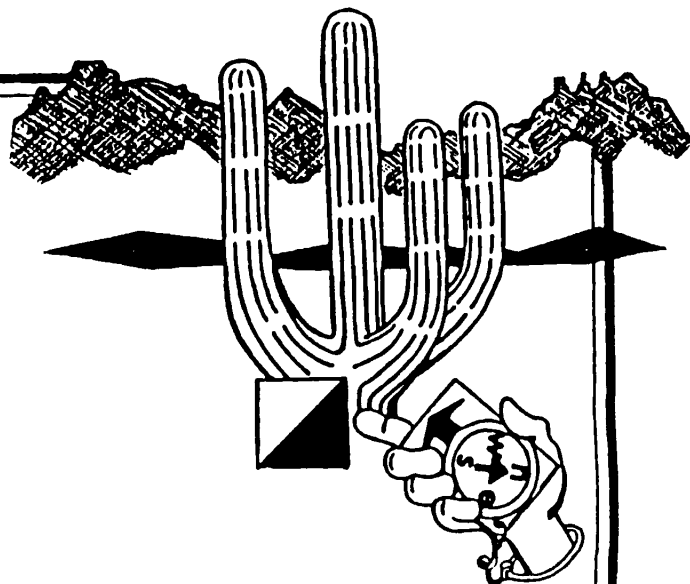

Even beginners are welcome! Beginner's clinics on the basics of compass and topographic map use will be held whenever requested. Courses can also be run recreationally (not timed) for those not interested in competing.

Location: Cave Creek/Gardner Canyon area of the Santa Rita Mountains.

Access: I-10 to State Hwy 83, then south to Gardner Canyon Road (4 miles north of Sonoita), then six miles west on the dirt road.

Map: Black and white (1988) with revisions, scale varies according to class (1:10,000- 1:12,500), contour interval 40 ft.

Classes: Elite men, Elite women, Men over 35, Women over 35, Men under 17, Women under 17, Beginner's course.

Awards: Special award to the top finisher in each class and top Arizona finisher (if different). Ribbons to the second and third place finishers in each class.

Camping: Free camping at the site. The club will provide sanitation facilities. There may be pools in streams for rinsing off; bring a solar shower bag for a hot shower. Bring drinking water.

Hotel/motel: The nearest is in Patagonia (the Stage Stop Inn, 22 miles from the meet site; 40-42\$/double, 60\$/four in a double). Numerous other accommodations in Sierra Vista (38 miles away) or Tucson (50 miles away).

Entry Fees: 4\$/one day, 7\$/2 days. TOC members one dollar less per day.

Start Times: 9:30 - noon each day. Pre-registration not required.

Additional: We will attempt to provide lodging and showers at TOC members homes in Tucson on Friday and Sunday evening. Call John Maier at 602-622-2895.
