## Arizona State Championships October 18-19, 1997

Tucson Orienteering Club is hosting the 1997 Arizona State Champs at Empire Ranch, site of the March 1997 ROGAINE. Basic information regarding the meet and the Advance Registration Form were included in the September newsletter. If you do not have a copy of this and need information regarding Classes (Category/Age Limits), Courses available, Directions to the meet, Camping, or Fees, please call Peg Davis at 628-8985.

*Preprinted maps will only be available to those who have preregistered.* All others must copy from the master maps **ON THE CLOCK**. The time you spend copying will be counted as part of your course competition time.

The extremely softhearted meet director (Peg Davis, 628-8985) will be taking registrations by phone from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. until October 15. To preregister by phone:

- ▶ State your name
- ▶ Color of the course you will run (White, Yellow, Orange, Green, Red)
- ▶ Days (Saturday, Sunday, or both)
- ▶ If you are entering as a team, the number of team members needing maps.

**Do not call if you are not positive about attending.** You are welcome to register on the day(s) of the event, but, as stated above, you will not get a preprinted map.

If you are not running competitively and will be at Empire Ranch on Saturday afternoon, you are cordially invited to retrieve controls for Auntie Marilyn (Cleavinger), our gracious course setter. Make your generosity known to her or Peg on Saturday morning.

The meet will follow the classic meet schedule on both Saturday and Sunday. Please allow 10 minutes to walk to the start from parking.

9:00 a.m.	Registration opens.	Noon	Last time to start a course.
9:30 a.m.	Courses open and beginners' clinic starts.	2:00 p.m.	Courses close. You must return by this time.

Awards will be presented on Sunday in a ceremony starting as much before 2 p.m. as possible.
